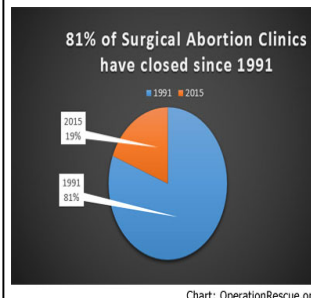

In all, **81** abortion clinics closed or reduced services in 2015.



Currently, there are **517 surgical abortion clinics** and **213 medication abortion clinics** remaining active in the U.S., the lowest numbers in decades.

In 1991, which is considered the high water mark for the number of abortion clinics, 2,176 surgical facilities offered abortions. Since then, 81% have closed.

“There is a direct correlation between the number of abortions and the number of abortion clinics. When abortion clinics close, abortion numbers decrease and lives are saved,” said Operation Rescue President Troy Newman.
